**THE QUAIN T CANADIAN VILLAGE --- BOUTIQUE SHOPS, HISTORIC INNS**

Enjoy a “truly upgraded fall day” in Niagara-on-the-Lake, about twenty minutes from Niagara Falls. This town is home to the Shaw Festival where productions from George Bernard Shaw and his contemporaries are performed, as in our relaxing and enjoyable overnight Shaw Festival Tour.

This quaint village, in Southern Ontario, is located where the Niagara River meets Lake Ontario. Interestingly, this is the only town in Canada that has a “*Lord Mayor*”, carrying on the tradition of many British cities.

We’ll be dining at the quaint Pillar & Post Inn, the same location that Queen Elizabeth has visited due to its fine dining and ambiance. Built in the 1800s, it is not far from the historic district, originally the home of many Scottish sea captains.

Then it’s off to shop the stores and boutiques in the town’s Heritage District. The shops are most unique, not the chain-type stores you may be familiar with. Located in these historic buildings are wine shops with tasting bars (after all, Niagara-on-the-Lake is home to twenty wineries), culinary delights, cafes, parks that take in the feelings of the 1920s, 1930s and 1940s as we stroll these streets. Looking for something unique, why not stop at “Beau Chapeau Hat Store” on Queen Street?



A couple of doors away, bring back memories at “Just Christmas”. After 30 years, it is still Canada’s oldest year-round holiday emporium, offering over 5,000 ornaments and other decorations.
