GRAND ILLUMINATION

FRIDAY – Historic Staunton, Virginia – First settled in 1732, Staunton served for a number of years as the regional capital for the Northwest Territory. When the legislators fled Richmond and Charlottesville during the American Revolution, it became the capital of Virginia for a brief period. Originally named Beverley’s Mill Place, it was renamed to honor Lady Rebecca Staunton, the wife of Royal Lieutenant Sir William Gooch. Dinner awaits us this evening. **(D)**



SATURDAY – Monticello and Richmond – We will be arriving at the former residence of our third president, Thomas Jefferson. Built from his own design on land that he, at the age of 26, had inherited from his father, was designed in a neoclassical style. It includes many of the same elements that were popular in late-1800s Europe.

Following our tour, we will travel into Richmond, the capital of the Commonwealth of Virginia. Our reps are pleased to be taking you to a historic place that embodies the spirit of Southern hospitality and charm at the Jefferson Hotel. Opened in 1895, this grand hotel was designed

in the beaux arts style with features refined over the past century. Cocktails await us today as we check into our hotel in Williamsburg. **(B, L, C)**

SUNDAY – Colonial Williamsburg’s Holiday Season & the Grand Illumination – We continue to “*step back in time*” at Colonial Williamsburg, experiencing the Revolutionary City dressed in timeless natural decorations or, perhaps, take in entertainment on the Market House stage.
