CINCY'S DINNER TRAIN, UNION STATION & CRUISE SAT-SUN APRIL 13-14, 2024

After a coffee break, our first stop in Cincinnati will be at Enter<u>train</u>ment Junction, the world's largest indoor train display with an area of over half a football field. It includes over 2 miles of track, 90 of the larger-sized G-scale locomotives and 1000 cars. This railroad museum shows how trains shaped the growth of the United States. The model trains are operated by a computer control system.

The "tour highlight" this evening will be special as we board the first of the two upscale meal experiences that should take you back to the "glory days of travel", the Cincinnati Railway's Dinner-Train.



This 3-hour 1940s-style train excursion, from

the heyday of rail travel, in vintage cars, includes a 4-course dinner. Trips in the past have included a live 40s-style entertainment such as "Chattanooga Choo Choo", "Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy" and other great hits of an era from the past. The train will depart promptly at 6 PM and travel to the downtown Cincinnati riverfront. Another tradition of those days of train travel includes their business-travel dress code; just as in those early years. You will not see blue jeans, flip-flops, throng sandals or sleeveless t-shirts . . . so different from the experiences that sometimes confronts us as we dine in some restaurants. They do, however, suggest being attired in 1940s vintage clothing, if you happen to have some in your closet, as if we are stepping out in a magazine of that era.

On board, we will be served four courses, with choices of <u>Prime Rib</u>, <u>Salmon with a Spicy Hoisin Glaze</u> or <u>Boneless Chicken Breast sautéed in white wine sauce</u>. Your entree will be accompanied by an appetizer, salad, vegetable, baked potato, choice of dessert, water, iced tea, and coffee. Vegetarian, Vegan and Gluten-free options are available.

We will again be stepping back in time as we board the riverboat for a **Dixieland Jazz Brunch Cruise**. Enjoy the "scrumptious cuisine" as you leisurely take in the fascinating Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky sights.

But, before we depart the area, we will be making a stop at the recently-remodeled Cincinnati Museum Center at Union Terminal. The Union Terminal was a significant develop-

ment in the history of the area's transportation. One of the last great train stations built, the structure became a city icon and one of the most-widely regarded examples of Art Deco style. Since opening in 1933, the Union Terminal has had a long and storied history, from welcoming soldiers home from World War II to becoming the home of three museums, a theater and the Cincinnati History Library & Archives. This unbelievable rail terminal was originally designed to accommodate 17,000 passengers and 216 trains each day.
