## 2-ISLAND HOPPING LUNCH-CRUISE WITH PUT-IN-BAY TRAM TOUR

**SAT JULY 13, 2024**

**Departures, as applic: Beachwood, Independence, Middleburg Hts, North Olmsted, Elyria.**

A cruise is certainly not “out of your reach” when you reside in Northern Ohio. We will be cruising to two of the most popular destinations in Lake Erie, Kelleys Island (originally occupied by the British) and South Bass Island (home of the resort village of Put-in-Bay). Enjoy fun in the sun on this “Island Hopping Cruise”, seeing Catawba, Marblehead and Lakeside.



Kelleys Island is home to both Inscription Rock and the Glacial Grooves, these are the largest grooves in the world, scoured into solid limestone bedrock about 18,000 years ago by the great ice sheet which covered a portion of North America. Today, a trough that is 400-feet long, 35-feet wide and up to 10-feet deep remains after the ice, which was hundreds of feet thick, carved out this area and the entire Lake Erie basin. Marine fossils have been discovered that date back 350 to 400 million years. You can generally rent a golf cart upon our arrival at Kelleys Island or you can enjoy the fresh breezes in this enchanting village.

An onboard picnic-style luncheon will be provided as we cruise to Put-In-Bay. You’ll be a part of history as we dock in the same bay that played an important role in the War of 1812 and was the “home base” of Oliver Hazard Perry in the “*Battle of Lake Erie*”, sometimes called the “*Battle of Put-In-Bay*”, during which nine vessels of the United States Navy defeated and captured six vessels of the British Navy, allowing America to take control of the lake. This is where the slogan began, “*We have met the enemy and they are ours*”. A tram will be meeting us for an included narrated tour of the island, another “little extra” when you travel with us.

You will have time to visit Perry’s Victory & International Peace Memorial, rising 352 feet over Lake Erie or, perhaps, enjoy an “adult beverage” or some homemade fudge at one of the “afternoon shows”. Feel free to visit Heineman Winery & Crystal Cave, the Car Museum or enjoy an Island tradition since 1917, the Kimberly Carousel along Delaware Avenue.
