Today, the Castle has been fully restored to its original grandeur, and features sweeping gardens based on European design, plus museum-quality collections which showcase castles, antique toys, royalty memorabilia from around the world, plus artifacts from World War I. The Castle's Garden Railroad is a 'must-see'; with more than a ½-mile of track and over 70 G-scale trains, it's the largest in the state. 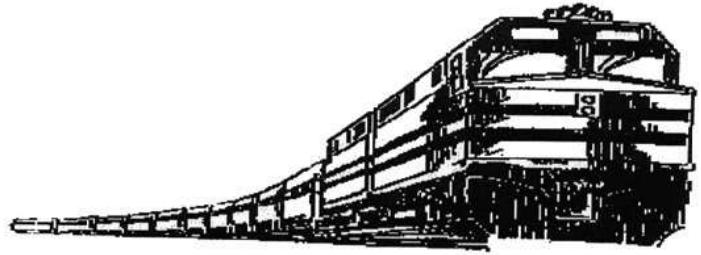

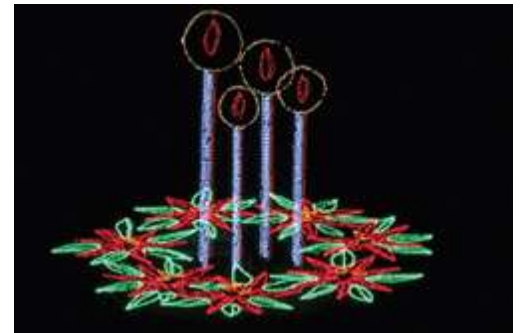
