Upon our return, the crew will be dropping us just feet from the historic Powerhouse, built in the 19th century and is now home of The Greater Cleveland Aquarium.



The easily recognizable Powerhouse was originally built to provide electricity for the streetcars that filled the streets of the city, it was known for its stylish arched windows and distressed brick walls. Prior to its absorption into Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, Brush Electric Light & Power Co. developed the equipment used for the city's first electric streetcar line. The line was operated under the East Cleveland Railway



Company. We will be seeing intriguing aquatic life from the Great Lakes and colorful sea creatures from around the globe.
