Frankenmuth is ever so beautiful in the colorful Fall season with its unique German-style buildings, shops and great food, a refreshing departure from the shopping experience of mega-malls! Founded in 1845, "Franken" depicts the province from which the founders came and "Muth" means "courage" in German. This tour provides a full day of dining, shopping and "leaf-peeping".



Since Frankenmuth is famous for delicious dining, we'll be including a great dinner at the Zehnder's of Frankenmuth on Main Street. Originally built as a hotel way back in 1856, it has been serving great dinners to guests since 1947. You'll find out why it remains a "*Frankenmuth tradition*" during our midday dinner, starting out with an appetizer platter and ending with pie ala mode during this multi-course meal.

You can visit Bronner's CHRISTmas Store or spend more time in the downtown area. Bronner's is home to the "*Silent Night Chapel*", a replica of the original chapel in Obendorf, Austria, where the song of the same name was first sung. The store is home to ornaments, Nativity scenes, decorated trees and collectibles. Shopping in downtown has been described as like traveling to Europe. From cuckoo clocks to quilts and ornaments to Brighton and Pandora, you can spoil yourself during this tour. The city also has over 100 boutiques and specialty shops with offerings from leather, apparel, collectables, gifts, toys, meats & cheeses and a country store. And, all the while, you can enjoy the wooden bridge, the river, the River Place Shops and a wonderful Glockenspiel.
