SPRING IN BAVARIA

Munich is a place where you might expect to see traditional garb, such as “Lederhosen Breeches” (traditional leather pants), but you just might be seeing them during our visit today in Frankenmuth. It’s almost like going to Bavaria with its beautiful buildings, shops, attractions, and its great food. “Franken” depicts the province from which the founders came and “muth” means “courage” in German. A tour offered at the same price as 2020!

The Frankenmuth Bavarian Inn, where we will be dining, is set along the riverfront. Enjoy a “casual stroll” as you listen to the hoofbeats of horse-drawn carriages. Be sure to notice the “architectural gems” such as their Glockenspiel and their quaint Holz Brücke Covered Bridge that provides a great view, overlooking the Cass River that flows through the town.



The Inn’s Glockenspiel, imported from Germany, is topped off with a 35-bell carillon and has become a landmark that depicts the “Legend of the Pied Piper of Hamelin” as it chimes during the day.

We’ll be enjoying a midday dinner, topped off with a freshly-made dessert! Afterwards, enjoy the hospitality of this town, filled with its Olde World European flavor.

The motorcoach will then be taking passengers to Bronner’s, the world’s largest Christmas store, overflowing with more than 6,000 styles of holiday ornaments and decorations.

There will also be time to visit the “*Silent Night Chapel*”, fashioned after the chapel in Oberndorf/Salzburg, Austria, where the song “*Silent Night*” was first sung on Christmas Eve in 1818.
