FRIDAY – Today you will see why our packages are "upgraded" over others you may have seen offered. We'll have all day to be "Dutch", starting with breakfast at the hotel before we depart for Windmill Island & Gardens with its 100,000 tulips . . . it's a beauty to behold. Always impressive, DeZwaan, America's oldest Dutch windmill, stands tall over the gardens. "DeZwaan" is Dutch for "The Swan" or "Graceful Bird". It was first erected in Krommenie, Holland (near Amsterdam) in 1761 and brought here in April 1965 and re-assembled. Then it is off to Dutch Village, Veldheer Tulip Gardens, DeKlomp Wooden Shoe & Delft Factory as well as the Queen's Inn for your luncheon.

You will be learning the history of both the Netherlands and the city of Holland, Michigan, founded by Dutch immigrants in the late 1840s.

We will be arriving back in town in time to purchase lunch before being seated in our reserved seats for the parade; this year we have again purchased "upgraded chairs" for your comfort. While seated, this will be the third entertainment as view the fascinating street cleaning by townsfolk wearing traditional costumes and wooden shoes. Once the streets are cleaned, the Musiekparade begins. There will be marching bands, floats, giant helium balloons, horses, Dutch dancers and many other participants who have come to this town to join in the festivities.
