Our Tour Planners have included a *"bit of history"* at our very first stop as we view stately (and oftentimes expensive) Motor Cars that were seen on the streets of the *"Windy City"* over the years along with other automobiles, military vehicles, and Presidential Carriages that were part of the late 1800s transportation scene; there is even the carriage that carried President Abraham Lincoln and other Presidents.

During the three days of this tour, we will be enjoying five meals, a live evening performance, a boat cruise, sightseeing, interesting attractions, admissions to two museums and, of course, two nights of rooms. One of our dinners will be at a "Mystery Destination", but we are pretty sure that you will be enjoying this specially-selected restaurant that is a long-time favorite.

We'll also be seeing the *"Chicago of Today"*, viewing the sights along the way. Did you know that the landmark Water Tower, built in 1869, was one of the only structures to survive the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 and today remains a symbol of Old Chicago? The Water Tower is located on North Michigan Avenue, in the Magnificent Mile shopping district.

The Museum of Science & Industry, is housed in the former Palace of Fine Arts from the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition. This museum, was initially endowed by a president of Sears, Roebuck & Company when it opened in 1933. Exhibits include a full-size replica of a coal mine, a German submarine (U-505) captured during WW II, a huge 3,500 square-foot model railroad and the command module of Apollo 8. You will also be seeing *"Silver Streak, the Pioneer Zephyr"*, the first diesel-powered streamlined stainless-steel passenger train. Most interesting is the new entranceway which has been constructed similar to the Louvre Pyramid.
