THE WILD PONIES OF ASSATEAGUE ISLAND, OCEAN CITY

SUN-WED SEPT 18-21, 2022

Departures, as applicable, from Elyria, North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Mayfield, Beachwood, Macedonia.

This tour to Maryland has a lot of interesting new stops but one that stands out is our visit to “Assateague, home to the Wild Horses”. Assateague Island National Seashore is located not



too far from our home for three nights, the Holiday Inn Oceanfront in Ocean City. The island has over 37 miles of beach and more than 300 wild ponies. These animals wander the beaches, inland pine forest, and salt marshes. Several theories about how the ponies arrived on the island have yet to be

confirmed. One theorizes that a Spanish galleon with a cargo of horses sank and the horses swam to the island. Another idea has the wild horses being brought here by the early Colonial Settlers. The ponies have adapted well since their diet includes saltmarsh cordgrass, dune grasses, bayberry twigs, rosehips & persimmons. While we are here, we should have a good view of the Assateague Lighthouse.

During our stay in Ocean City we will be dining at some of the more popular restaurants, including the “Touch of Italy”. Harrison’s Harborwatch (overlooking Assateague) and Dickens Dinner theater. But these are just the start. We will be taking an Eco-Cruise aboard “The Explorer”, visiting the Lifesaving Station to learn a bit of Ocean City’s past, walking along the Boardwalk, enjoying the Bay and “stepping back in time” in the quaint town of Berlin.
