

In 1994, *"The Shawshank Redemption"* hit the screens across America. Originally adapted from a story by Stephen King, the movie was nominated for seven Academy Awards that year. It tells the story of a banker who spent nearly two decades in Shawshank Reformatory for a crime he continued to claim that he was innocent of. Eventually, if you remember the movie, he manages to escape.

We will be traveling along the "Road to Buxton", the road in the movie that Red walked along once he got out of the red truck.

We will be touring the castle-like Ohio State Reformatory (where portions of *"The Shawshank Redemption"* were filmed, as well as three other motion pictures), made popular on the television series *"Mysteries of the Abandoned"*. While this facility housed over 155,000 men in its lifetime, it closed its doors on December 31, 1990. Today, visitors from all over the world tour the majestic structure, including a number of our groups over the past several years.

We will also be seeing the site of the "Brewer Hotel" where actor James Whitmore (Brooks) went to stay after being paroled from the prison. You'll see the bench that Brooks sat on while feeding the pigeons, hoping that his friend "Jake", a pet crow, will show up . . . although he never does.

We will also be visiting the 1928 vintage baroque-style music palace, the Renaissance Theatre, where the movie first premiered in 1994, seeing the pit, hearing celebrity stories and enjoying the same view that the stars do from center
