The border is back open so you can enjoy this fall day in Niagara-on-the-Lake, about twenty minutes from Niagara Falls. This town is home to the Shaw Festival where productions from George Bernard Shaw and his contemporaries are performed, as in our relaxing and enjoyable overnight Shaw Festival Tour.

This charming village is situated where the Niagara River meets Lake Ontario. Interestingly, this is the only town in Canada that has a “*Lord Mayor*”, carrying on the tradition of many British cities.

We’ll be dining at a quaint restaurant that is not far from the historic district.



Then it’s off to shop the stores and boutiques in the town’s Heritage District. The shops are most unique, not the chain-type stores you may be familiar with. Located in these historic buildings are wine shops with tasting bars (after all, Niagara-on-the-Lake is home to twenty wineries), culinary delights, cafes, parks that take in the feelings of the 1920s, 1930s and 1940s as we stroll these streets. Looking for something unique, why not stop at “Beau Chapeau Hat Store” on Queen Street?



A couple of doors away, bring back memories at “Just Christmas”. After 30 years, it is still Canada’s oldest year-round holiday emporium, offering over 5,000 ornaments and other decorations.

Or join with the other visitors who are strolling the district and stopping at other venues that just may be of special interest to you, possibly pampering yourself by taking home luxury bath and body products from Maison Apothecare.
