## GETTING IN THE MOOD FOR SPRINGTIME – BLOOMS & BUTTERFLIES AND ADMISSIONS TO THE KING TUT EXHIBIT THUR MARCH 23, 2023

The Franklin Park Conservatory will be awash in the vibrant colors of the stunning glass artwork by Dale Chihuly . . . the same renowned artist whose Café we include during our tours of the Frederik Meijer Gardens in Grand Rapids, with its dozens of individual blown-glass pieces, spanning the ceiling in a spectrum of colors. Today we will be seeing the permanent Chihuly collection, created by the master who began experimenting with glassblowing and eventually was awarded a Louis Comfort Tiffany Foundation grant for his work. He later traveled to Venice to learn the detailed intricacies of blowing glass.

Getting ready for Springtime, the exhibits will include the Blooms & Butterflies Exhibition. Their Pacific Island Water Garden will have hundreds of tropical butterflies in free flight, and lots of butterfly nectar flowering plants to feed the butterflies (things like jatropha, pentas and lantana). You will also be able to visit the Himalayan Mountain, Tropical Rainforest, Desert and Pacific Island biomes.



After lunch, which we have included, we will be traveling the short distance to the brand-new **“King Tut Exhibit – The Pharaoh’s Tomb and His Treasures”** at the Center of Science & Industry. King Tutankhamun (King Tut for short!) became ruler of Ancient Egypt when he was just nine years old and, upon his passing, the Boy King was buried, in a coffin surrounded by 5,000 priceless treasures.
