
## **Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary**

"DeZwaan" is Dutch for "The Swan" or "Graceful Bird". It was first erected in Krommenie, Holland (near Amsterdam) in 1761 and brought here in April 1965 and re-assembled. Then it is off to Dutch Village, Veldheer Tulip Gardens, DeKlomp Wooden Shoe & Delft Factory as well as the Queen's Inn for your luncheon.
