MACKINAC ISLAND WEEKEND, LILACS

FRI-SUN JUNE 9-11, 2023

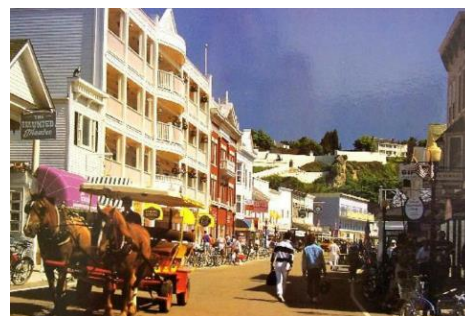
Departures, as applic: Beachwood/Orange, Independence, Parma/Cleve West. Middleburg Hts, Elyria, Sandusky.



FRIDAY – We will be traveling westward and then northward, with a stop to purchase lunch in Birch Run, Michigan. Afterwards, we will continue on to Mackinaw City to check into the Holiday Inn Express for our two-night stay. We'll take a few minutes to “freshen up” and then the bus will be taking us into town where you can purchase dinner. The evening will be yours to enjoy the hotel's swimming pool or relaxing whirlpool.

SATURDAY – Mackinac Island – Breakfast is included at the Inn before we travel over to the dock to board the 8:30 AM high-speed ferry to Mackinac Island where we will be greeted by the fragrant smell of the lilacs that fill the air during late Spring.

Here we will be met by a Mackinac Island Carriage for a narrated tour of the Island, a beautiful setting where transportation is by horse carriage, bicycle or foot. This should be a great time to visit with **the smell and beauty of lilacs** during the Lilac Festival, a celebration that blends the Island's historic varieties of lilacs, many of which were brought over during the Colonial era.



The tour carriages will be dropping us off at the Grand Hotel where our tour coordinators have included the legendary Grand Luncheon, served in the second-floor Main Dining Room of the Grand Hotel. Your table will be overlooking the world's longest porch and the hotel's many American flags, as well as the glistening Straits of Mackinac.

There will be time, after lunch, to visit the shops in the downtown area as well as places that make great fudge . . . to take home to those who missed out on this tour. You just might be able to figure out why visitors to the Island are sometimes referred to as “fudgies”.

All tour details are anticipated at the time that the Scheduled Tour Brochure was prepared and specific stops and/or other inclusions are subject to change or elimination without notice. Tours typically depart between 6 AM and 8:30 AM with the exact time shown on the itinerary you will receive approximately one to two weeks prior to the tour departure. Most tours return about 9 PM to 10:30 PM, although this may vary.



We have an Island departure aboard the 4 PM boat back to the mainland where the bus will be making a drop-off at the Mackinaw Crossings for those who would like to shop or buy dinner here, for those still hungry. For those 19 and over, you can travel across the Mighty Mac Bridge as we visit the Kewadin Casino in St. Ignace, Michigan; each passenger is scheduled to receive a bonus for free slot play. We will be here about 3 hours. **(B, L)**

SUNDAY – Frankenmuth enroute home – Breakfast is included at the hotel before we say “Good-Bye” to our hosts and the beautiful scent of the lilacs on the Island. We will board the bus and travel south to one of the most-visited areas of Michigan, the “Bavarian town” of Frankenmuth.

A midday dinner awaits us at the Frankenmuth Bavarian Inn (boasting its impressive Glockenspiel with animated figurines) before we take some time to shop, to visit attractions such as Bronner’s CHRISTmas Store and the Silent Night Chapel, a replica of the original Silent Night Memorial Chapel located in Oberndorf, Austria. Here the song “Silent Night” was first sung. At the time announced we will depart for home with a rest stop enroute. **(B, D)**
