

Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

NEW ENGLAND – CAPE COD – NANTUCKET – PROVINCETOWN MON-SAT JULY 10-15, 2023

Departures, as applic: Elyria, Parma/Cleve.West, Middleburg Hts, Independence, Beachwood, Mayfield, Ashtabula.

We have been offering this tour for many years and this itinerary includes additional time in Boston, Plymouth, the Island of Nantucket, a casino-resort and the very tip of the Cape, Provincetown. Our local guides will be showcasing the fascinating points along the way as we travel through Massachusetts and you'll even have a chance to order lobster or, an alternate entrée, during our *"Cape Cod Experience"*. We've included three nights of rooms at the Holiday Inn Hyannis, located in the city referred to, by many, as the *"Capital of the Cape"*.

MONDAY – Our staff has a few interesting stops for us as we travel eastward through East Aurora, New York, the hometown of Millard Fillmore and the birthplace of the Roycroft Arts & Crafts Movement. We will be staying at the Turning Stone Resort in Verona, where dinner (by voucher) awaits and, for those interested, *"gaming action"*, with some *"slot free play"*. **(D)**

TUESDAY – Plymouth Rock and Hyannis -- After breakfast in one of the hotel restaurants, we depart for Massachusetts. We will be making several stops as we travel today including Plymouth, best known for Plymouth Rock, for a Guided Tour with a local guide, and seeing the location where the Pilgrims were thought to have disembarked in 1620 on their journey to this country. Dinner awaits us upon our arrival at the Holiday Inn Hyannis. **(B, D)**



WEDNESDAY – Cruising to Nantucket – Following breakfast we will travel to the nearby dock in Hyannis to board the boat that will take us to Nantucket. If you are not already aware of all that this destination has to offer, it is an island about twenty miles long that is one of the most beautiful in New England, with a long history of whaling, but now thrives on its tourism that brings many visitors during the warmer months. We've included a cruise to Nantucket, an island tour, admissions to the museum and time for lunch on your own. For almost 100 years, this island was a center of the whaling industry. While relatively dangerous, it was quite a lucrative industry, making it one of the wealthiest places in the country. Needless to say, every captain on Nantucket had a "tale worth telling".

We will be traveling along the Old Kings Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history, viewing sites such as the John F. Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial and St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer parish of the Kennedy family, before our dinner and a lively show. **(B, D)**



FRIDAY – Boston – This expanded itinerary has us traveling north about an hour and arriving at Boston’s Quincy Market in the heart of the city for our lunch stop. During the afternoon, our guide will be introducing you to Boston Proper and the many landmarks in this historic city, where history is on every street corner, including the location of the Boston Tea Party. This evening we will be staying in Central New York State. **(B, D)**

SATURDAY – Breakfast is served before we say “good-bye” to the beauty of the region. Stops will be made along the way and, enroute, we have included a special mid-day dinner before continuing our trip homeward with great memories of our *Cape Cod Experience*. **(B, D)**
