German descendants made up a third of the entire population of the city of Columbus. You will be learning stories of its history as we travel the brick streets with its wrought-iron fences in this historic district.

In keeping with the theme of this tour, we will be dining in the heart of German Village at a restaurant that’s been there since 1886. Here, we will be dining on German specialties and, this year, our staff has added entertainment to enjoy during lunch, even as we kept the same price for the third consecutive year!



There will be a brief stop before we leave town at the shop operated by the “Flag Lady”. She offers most every type of U.S.-made flag, including the “*Betsy Ross*” and the “*Spirit of ‘76*” versions to display to say that we are proud to be Americans!
