TIFFIN, GLASS BLOWING TOUR & MORE

Departure locations, if applic: Beachwood/Orange, Independence, Middleburg Hts, No.Olmsted, Elyria.

The history of Tiffin, Ohio, goes back to 1835 when it was incorporated by an Act of the Ohio Legislature and, fifteen years later, it merged with Fort Ball (originally a military depot during the War of 1812) and became the expanded city that it is now. Industry flourished for many years due to the discovery, in 1888, of its vast amounts of natural gas. The city was also the location of St. Paul's United Methodist Church which was the first church in the world to be lit by Thomas Edison's light bulbs and the first public building in the United States to be wired for electricity as it was being constructed. Tiffin has been known for being home to both Heidelberg University and Tiffin University, as well as the town where Ballreich Potato Chips are manufactured.



For many years, the city was an important glass and porcelain manufacturing center. While many of these companies are no longer around, there are several shops that still carry on this tradition. One of the first businesses in this region was a flour mill along the river so we will be dining at Pioneer Mill, enjoying some long-time favorites in a building constructed in 1822. After dining, we will be visiting the Tiffin Glass Museum & Shoppes before some free time to visit a couple of the local merchants of the town.
