Enjoy a balmy Fall afternoon in Niagara-on-the-Lake, just a few minutes from Niagara Falls. This town is home to the Shaw Festival where productions from George Bernard Shaw and his contemporaries are performed, as in our overnight Shaw Festival Tour, this year with the musical "Gypsy".

This charming village is situated where the Niagara River meets Lake Ontario. Interestingly, this is the only town in Canada that has a "Lord Mayor", carrying on the tradition of many British cities. We'll be dining at a quaint restaurant that is not far from the historic district.

Then it's off to shop the stores and boutiques in the town's Heritage District. Just in time for the upcoming Holidays, the village is home to Canada's oldest holiday emporium, offering ornaments and other decorations.

Before leaving Canada, we'll be stopping at the Duty-Free Shoppe to take advantage of the U.S.-Canadian exchange rates on jewelry, perfumes and, of course, "adult beverages".

A Passport or Passport Card is required for this tour. An enhanced driver's license is currently not an acceptable form of identification for the border crossing.
