We'll *"step back in time"*, experiencing the Revolutionary City dressed in timeless natural decorations and taking in the entertainment and musical performances on the Market House stage. It is fascinating to watch as the candles are lit in the homes and public buildings and enjoying the sparkle of fireworks, shot off from the Capitol and the Governor's Palace into the night sky before returning to the beautiful Embassy Suites Williamsburg. In the late 18th Century, different customs were followed by different families, as we plan to show you. First settled in 1732, Historic Staunton, Virginia, served for a number of years as the regional capital for the Northwest Territory. When the legislators fled Richmond and Charlottesville during the American Revolution, it became the capital of Virginia for a brief period. Originally named Beverley's Mill Place, it was renamed to honor Lady Rebecca Staunton, the wife of Royal Lieutenant Sir William Gooch. We will be arriving at the former residence of our third president, Thomas Jefferson. Built from his own design on land that he, at the age of 26, had inherited from his father, was designed in a neoclassical style. It includes many of the same elements that were popular in late-1800s Europe.
