Our Tour Planners have included a "bit of history" at our very first stop as we view stately (and oftentimes expensive) Motor Cars that were seen on the streets of the "Windy City" over the years along with other automobiles, military vehicles, and Presidential Carriages that were part of the late 1800s transportation scene; there is even the carriage that carried President Abraham Lincoln.



During the three days of this tour, we will be dining at the top-rated "Maggiano's Clark & Grand", which your Tour Staff has chosen to further ugrade this Chicago Tour. Be prepared to savor the rich flavors of dishes inspired by traditional recipes. Including this special dinner, there will be a total of five meals, a live evening dinner-show, a boat cruise, sightseeing, two museums and, of course, two nights of rooms.



We'll also be seeing the "Chicago of Today", viewing the sights along the way. Did you know that the landmark Water Tower, built in 1869, was one of the only structures to survive the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 and, today, it remains a symbol of Old Chicago? The Water Tower is located on North Michigan Avenue, in the Magnificent Mile shopping district.



The Museum of Science & Industry, is housed in the former "Palace of Fine Arts" from the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition. This museum, was initially endowed by a President of Sears, Roebuck & Company when it opened in 1933.

Most interesting is the new entranceway which has been constructed similar to the iconic Louvre Pyramid in Paris.

But that is far from all you will be seeing. One of the most fascinating inclusions will have you experiencing the "legendary Chicago architecture tour". You'll be seeing the 130-year long history as we travel through the heart of the city. As in the past, we've included some time for shopping or browsing at Navy Pier.

We will also be dining at the Schaumburg Castle with its colossal stone tower and emerald lawn. While it's beautiful on the outside, the experience you will be having inside this evening is even more memorable. We will dine in the festive and colorful atmosphere of the theater while entertainers aboard beautiful equine perform medieval-style games and jousting.

As always, we will be having a mid-day dinner as we travel homeward through Indiana's Amish Country.
