The Hocking Valley Railroad dates back many years, originally operating as the Mineral Railroad which began service in 1864; it ran its trains primarily between Toledo and Columbus, with much of its services being utilized by the coal mines in the Athens-Nelsonville region. In 1910, this rail line became part of the Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad (now the Chessie System).



We will be taking a rail excursion through the countryside of Southeastern Ohio this afternoon, following the Sunday Breakfast Buffet in a rivertown Inn as we travel to Nelsonville. Be sure to bring your appetite since we sure don't want to see you go hungry today!
