It was back in the early 1900s that the rich and famous were known for their homes and hospitality offered to their friends. Join us on this tour as we travel to Rochester, Michigan, to celebrate almost a century of this historic landmark that's as impressive and beautiful as ever.

Meadow Brook is the estate built by one of the automotive aristocracy's most remarkable women, Matilda Dodge Wilson, and her second husband, a lumber broker. Constructed between 1926 and 1929 for \$4 million, really a lot of money back then, Meadow Brook Hall represents one of the finest examples of Tudor-revival architecture in America. With 110 rooms, it is the fourth largest mansion in the United States. And, befitting the guests in such a gorgeous home, we'll be "dining in style", on a luncheon reminiscent of the grandeur of the estate, touring the elegant rooms of the grand manor and following the path to Knole Cottage and Danny's Cabin.



This Tudor-Revival style mansion continues to impress over a century later, as a historic house museum, event & wedding venue, and cultural center renowned for its grand scale, lush gardens and stunning architecture. It is certainly going to impress those traveling with us during this tour, a date we've selected in anticipation that there will be many vibrant fall foliage colors greeting us as we travel along, just as we did during our tour last October that delighted so many guests.
