## APPLE BUTTER STIRRIN' IN A CANAL TOWN FRIDAY, OCT 18, 2024

For over a half century, the **Apple Butter Stirrin' Festival** has been recapturing the flavor of **an old-time harvest celebration** in a restored Ohio and Erie Canal town within the Appalachian region. Historic Roscoe Village, was laid out in 1816, originally being named Caldersburgh after its founder and local merchant, James Calder. The village was once a bustling port until the canal was hit by a flood in 1913. The village, the local portions of the canal and the intricate architecture have been restored over the years and now boasts delightful shops, restaurants, and tours of the historic buildings. Last year it was suggested that options be made available for lunch, as there is a restaurant or two plus food trucks to select from, utilizing vouchers or other altneratives to just one "fixed" location that may, or may not, be to your liking, in the heart of this Restored Town.

The highlight of this annual event is the making of homemade apple butter in large copper kettles over crackling open wood fires. While apple butter may be the "common thread" during our visit, the festival also offers handmade crafts, demonstrations, and outdoor stage



entertainment. You'll be smelling the fresh apple butter simmering as you stroll along the street, lined with more than a hundred craft and food vendors, and listening to the tunes of both bluegrass and music from days gone by. Various events and Living History Tours are held during the festival, before or after our midday luncheon.
