Salem, Massachusetts, is a historic coastal city on the North Shore of Greater Boston. The Europeans first settled this region in the mid-1600s and, within years, it became one of the most important seaports of its day. It is also home to the House of Seven Gables. The city has retained its historic residential neighborhoods in the Federal Street District and is possibly best known for the Salem Witch Trials of 1692 and, even today, it is claimed that some of their police cars carry the witch logo on the sides.

While the tour focuses on Salem, we will be starting, upon our arrival, at Boston's Quincy Market where, for 250 years Bostonians have been enjoying the cobblestones under their

feet as they shop and the entertainers performing in the market. What better way to start our visit in Boston than with dinner here this evening. During one of our meals on this tour, you will be able to select your choice of entrée, including a lobster for those preferring it.
