The holidays are a great opportunity to enjoy the Christmas season and two places that celebrate it *“in style”* are the Biltmore Estate and the Smoky Mountains, each in their own unique way. The holidays at Biltmore are celebrated with incredible decorations, live music, and candlelight evening experiences. Imagine more than 55 hand-decorated Christmas trees adorning the home and estate, the centerpiece being a 35-foot beauty.



Saturday evening starts out with dinner and a live performance of the musical *“Christmas Show”*. In Asheville we will be enjoying a dinner and touring George Vanderbilt’s 250-room chateau, built over 128 years ago. It’s as impressive today as it ever was, a wonder of architecture and hospitality. You’ll also be visiting the beautiful gardens and grounds surrounding it, designed by renowned landscape architects. Docents will be greeting you in many of the rooms that you will be visiting, allowing you to learn more about the house, its inhabitants and the guests who frequented here.



History has it that when the Vanderbilts opened Biltmore, it was on Christmas Eve of 1895, and they invited both family and friends to visit them on this *“special day”*. That joyous holiday tradition has continued through the years with its large Christmas tree, mistletoe, holly, and garland hung throughout the house.

Each evening Biltmore glows with candlelight and firelight, just as when the Vanderbilts would welcome guests. Musicians throughout the house will perform seasonal favorites as you visit the rooms of Biltmore House and feel the warmth of the dozens of lighted fireplaces. During this evening tour, it’s amazing how the rooms “*take on a magical glow*” as candles illuminate the holiday decor.



Along the way we’ll be enjoying dinner and, in Pigeon Forge, a lot of Holiday Entertainment including:

- Evening Dinner and the Christmas Show at Dolly Parton’s Stampede Spectacular.
- The Three Bears Gift Shop, the most popular store of its kind in the region, with cute baby bear cubs.
- A visit to the Incredible Christmas Place; Christmas décor, ornaments & more.
- Dinner will be served at Johnny Carino’s in The Smokies.
- Reserved seating at the *Country Tonite Christmas Show*, consistently rated # 1.
- Reserved seats for Pigeon Forge’s newest theater show, “Array Christmas Show”.
- The Island Shopping-Restaurant area, possibly trying a sample or two of Tennessee Moonshine which we have included!
- Admissions to tour “Titanic”, docked right along the main street of town.
