

# Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

**CINCY'S DINNER TRAIN, UNION STATION & CRUISE SAT-SUN APRIL 12-13, 2025**

**Departure locations, if applic: Beachwood/Orange, Independence, Parma/Cleve West, Middleburg Hts, Mansfield, Grove City.**

After a coffee break, our first stop in Cincinnati will be at the American Sign Museum. While we are all used to seeing signs over the years, their complexity varies from “very basic” to “quite complex”. During our visit to this most interesting place, you will be seeing the full range of signs, including many colorful and historic creations and, impressive bright neon designs that made places easy to locate or a simple sign that strictly advised “open”.

The “tour highlight” this evening will be special as we board the first of the two upscale meal experiences that should take you back to the “glory days of travel”, the **Cincinnati Railway’s Dinner-Train.**

This 3-hour 1940s-style train excursion, from the heyday of rail travel, in vintage cars, includes a 4-course dinner. Trips in the past have included a live 40s-style entertainment such as “*Chattanooga Choo Choo*”, “*Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy*” and other great hits of an era from the past. The train will depart promptly at 6 PM and travel to the downtown Cincinnati riverfront. Another tradition of those days of train travel includes their business-travel dress code, just as in those early years. You will not see blue jeans, flip-flops, thong sandals or sleeveless t-shirts . . . so different from the experiences that sometimes confront us as we dine in some restaurants. They do, however, suggest being attired in 1940s vintage clothing, if you happen to have some in your closet, as if we are stepping out in a magazine of that era.

On board, we will be served four courses, with choices of [Prime Rib](#), [Salmon with a Spicy Hoisin Glaze](#) or [Boneless Chicken Breast sautéed in white wine sauce](#), although there is a chance that the yet-to-be-announced choices could vary for 2025, as various other inclusions and themes on the train may vary, since new ownership took over since last season. These will be included in the itinerary mailed out prior to the tour departure.

*Please note that the train is not handicapped-accessible and children under the age of 12 are not permitted aboard the train. All Aboarddd!!!!!!*

On Sunday, we will be enjoying a leisurely morning before we travel the short distance to the Ohio River. We will again be stepping back in time as we board the riverboat for a **Dixieland Jazz Brunch Cruise**. Enjoy the “scrumptious cuisine” as you leisurely take in the fascinating Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky sights.

But, before we depart the area, we will be making a stop at the recently remodeled Cincinnati Museum Center at Union Terminal. The Union Terminal was a significant development in the history of the area’s transportation. One of the last great train stations built, the structure became a city icon and one of the most-widely regarded examples of Art Deco style. Since opening in 1933, the Union Terminal has had a long and storied history, from welcoming soldiers home from World War II to becoming the home of three museums, a theater and the Cincinnati History Library & Archives. This unbelievable rail terminal was originally designed to accommodate 17,000 passengers and 216 trains each day.
