We have discovered that some people, even long-time residents, may not be aware of the many wonderful changes that have taken place in the Cleveland area. This is your chance to bring yourself up to date during this local touring.



We will be guests at the Hay-McKinney Mansion, built in 1911 for Clara Hay, the daughter of the railroad magnate, Amasa Stone, and the wife of John Hay. This home replaced the original house along Millionaire's Row. After our luncheon, we've included admissions to the Cleveland Botanical Gardens, the first place of its type in the country.

Since the city was home to several amusement parks, you will have a chance to go back in time with a ride on the historic Euclid Beach Amusement Park's Grand Carousel.

The Garden Center of Greater Cleveland opened in 1930. Besides its "resident exhibits", you may also be seeing special collections such as tropical and exotic plants. At the centerpiece of University Circle, the Cleveland Museum of Art, we will be greeted by "The Thinker", the bronze structure by Auguste Rodin, hearing about the missing legs on the statue from your Tour Director. We will be driving through the area donated by, and named after, the founder of Western Union Telegraph Company.

Along the way, we will be traveling through the Cleveland Cultural Gardens, seeing, from the window of the coach, the various gardens that honor citizens who arrived in Cleveland from other countries. We will also be viewing the impressive outdoor chandelier with 4200 crystals, reminiscent of the beautiful lights seen inside the theater lobbies and learning about the docking station atop a bank for dirigibles traveling between Detroit and New York.
