He commanded American troops in a number of battles, including during the Siege of Yorktown, while commuting back and forth to Europe where he served as a Lieutenant General in the French Army during the French Revolution.

We will be dining in a hotel known for its collection of long rifles, each identified for its place in history.

We'll then travel to the dock on the Ohio River to board the paddlewheel riverboat, cruising Marietta's two navigable rivers, and crossing the border into West Virginia. There is nothing like the gentle splash of the paddlewheel on a warm afternoon to remind you of a bygone era.
