AMERICA'S PROUD PAST AT DENNISON DEPOT FRI JULY 11, 2025

Departures, as applic: Elyria, No.Olmsted, Middleburg Hts., Independence, Beachwood/Orange

Today we will be touring the Village of Dennison, steeped in history and patriotism. Recognized as a National Historic Landmark, the Dennison Railroad Depot has been acclaimed *"the most significant remaining example in the nation of a railroad canteen, still reflecting its World War II heritage"*.

"During that war, 1.3 million service members were served free food by 4,000 volunteers at the Dennison Depot Salvation Army Servicemen's Canteen. These service men and women traveled by troop train along the National Defense Strategic Railway and stopped at the Depot as they were going off to fight in the war.



The "homefront hospitality" became so well known, that the nickname *"Dreamsville, USA"* was used to describe this canteen by the soldiers.

The 1873 Pennsylvania Railroad Station has many stories, some of which you will be hearing. We've also included time to tour the railroad cars and the theater that features a film on its history.

As always, a delicious luncheon and perhaps some shopping time has been included today.
