## DINING AT THE TROPIANA, WITH THE LUCY-DESI MUSEUM & NATIONAL COMEDY CENTER SPECIAL SAT JULY 12, 2025

The “*History of Comedy*” and the history of the resort town of Jamestown are intertwined since we will be visiting both today. Back in the 1800s, Western New York was oftentimes visited by folks like Henry Ford and Harvey Firestone during the summer before a number of these prominent industrialists would travel down to their winter homes in Fort Myers, Florida.



A bit of nostalgia descends upon us as we arrive in Jamestown, the birthplace of Lucille Ball, “the person whose face has been seen by more people more often than any other in history”. This tour includes both The Lucy-Desi Museum and The National Comedy Center. At the Lucy-Desi Museum you’ll hear about some of the antics from Lucy’s childhood as we view screenings and excerpts of their shows. Did you know during August of this year would have been Lucy Ricardo’s 116th birthday? The second visit will be at the National Comedy Center near the Lucy-Desi Museum. Many people are not aware of it, but the center is the Country’s “official cultural institution, dedicated to presenting the story of comedy and preserving its heritage for future generations with state-of-the-art technology”. Our arrival at the National Comedy Center also is a Special Package since it coincides with the Comedy Festival, where many different comedians will share the stage! You may just be able to catch a show. 2025 marks the induction of Joan Rivers into the National Comedy Center; not only will we arrive in time for the festival, there will be a new archive and interactive exhibit showcasing her talent. By now, you will have seen why we wanted to include both museums in this package to Lucy’s Hometown.

To give us additional time in Jamestown, we will be including lunch at the Tropicana Club, a recreation of Ricky Ricardo’s famous Manhattan night club. The Tropicana Club is not open to the public, this is a real treat!
