

## Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

**MAGICAL MARITIMES, NOVA SCOTIA, NEW BRUNSWICK & PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND**      **MON JULY 14 – FRI JULY 25, 2025**

The Maritimes are made up of the Canadian provinces of Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. The region has both islands and peninsulas, offering dramatic views and experiences of a lifetime as they blend in with the Appalachian Highlands and the Atlantic Ocean. Over the twelve days of this tour, we will be seeing history, sites and landscapes in a package that includes twenty-three wonderful meals. We will be touring Bar Harbor, Acadia National Park and Cadillac Mountain before boarding the CAT High-Speed Ferry as we travel to Yarmouth, Nova Scotia; dinner will be served aboard the vessel as we cross the Gulf of Maine.



One morning begins with a scenic drive along the Evangeline Trail and Fundy Shore, famous for its coastal beauty. We'll stop at Annapolis Royal, where you'll have time for lunch in this picturesque town filled with maritime charm. In the afternoon, we visit the Grand-Pré National Historic Site, a beautiful 14-acre memorial dedicated to Nova Scotia's early Acadian settlers. As we continue, you'll see the statue of Evangeline, the heroine immortalized by Henry Wadsworth Longfellow. Peggy's Cove is a quaint and picturesque fishing village, famous for its rugged beauty and artistic inspiration. You'll visit the iconic lighthouse, which also serves as the village post office; this offers a unique "photo opportunity". We will be touring Halifax to see the Citadel, a historic star-shaped fort perched on a hilltop. You'll also visit Fairview Lawn Cemetery, the resting place of many Titanic victims, and stroll through the stunning Halifax Public Gardens. We cap off our day with a scenic dinner cruise around Halifax Harbor tonight.

We will journey along the dramatic Marine Drive, where the rocky coastline and quiet beaches offer breathtaking views. We continue through the town of Antigonish and cross over to Cape Breton Island, where we visit the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site. Later, we arrive at our Cape Breton resort for a relaxing two-night stay. The next day we will be exploring one of the most scenic drives in North America, the Cabot Trail! This coastal route offers panoramic views of the ocean and mountains. We will also be learning about the rich heritage of the Gaelic people during a visit to the Gaelic College of Celtic Arts and Crafts. Departing Cape Breton, we will travel to Pictou for a ferry ride across Northumberland Strait to Prince Edward Island for a tour of Charlottetown, the capital. This evening, we have arranged a lobster supper (or alternative), a must-try local tradition!

We have so much more to share with you, including the Green Gables House, made famous in the beloved novel, Anne of Green Gables. We will continue into New Brunswick, where we'll experience the optical illusion of Magnetic Hill and touring Halifax where we will be seeing the incredible power of nature at the Reversing Falls, where the Bay of Fundy's high tides reverse the flow of the Saint John River.
