

# Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

**WISCONSIN & DOOR COUNTY**

**SUN-SAT AUGUST 3-9, 2025**

**Departures, as applic: Beachwood/Orange, Independence, Middleburg Hts, No.Olmsted, Elyria, Sandusky.**

While we are probably all familiar with Wisconsin and what many of its areas have for travelers, Door County may not be quite as familiar. This region has so much to offer visitors, being set on 300 miles of Lake Michigan shoreline with 11 lighthouses. It is also one of the top 5 cherry-producing locations in the country and has no national chains. Door County took its name from the straits between the mainland and Washington Island. The name comes from a translation from the French voyageur term, "La Porte des Morts".

Door County is most inviting with its picturesque coastal towns & shops, fish boils, cherry and apple orchards . . . leading to many referring to it as the "Cape Cod of the Midwest."

Our tour will be arriving on the first day at Harbor Shores Hotel on Geneva Lake. The next day we will be cruising Lake Geneva on a Mailboat. This area is one of only a handful of places left in the country where mail is still delivered by boat. This is most historic since, with over 100 years of mail service, mail is still delivered to about 75 homes around the lake on a daily basis from June 15 to September 15. After lunch we will be touring Black Point Estate & Gardens, a Victorian estate built on Lake Geneva for a beer baron from Chicago back during the last 1800s.



Our Blue Heron Boat Tour will be taking us through Horicon Marsh, the largest freshwater cattail marsh in the northern hemisphere. Afterwards, we have set up a lunch and tour at La Clare Farms, well known for its various cheeses, including a special blend made from goat's milk. We will also be visiting Door Peninsula Winery & Distillery to enjoy a tasting.

We've included a visit to one of the many lighthouses in Door County, specifically the one located at Eagle Bluff Tower. Built in 1868, the lighthouse still guides vessels through the narrow Strawberry Channel and is listed on the [National Register of Historic Places](#).

But, even with all of these inclusions, our planners also have us visiting the Door County Maritime Museum in Sturgeon Bay, Milwaukee touring, a visit to the Wade House, lunch stop at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Market Hall, a visit to Domes Botanical Gardens and both a tour and dinner at the Harley Davidson Museum.
