When the Germans arrived in Central Ohio, they brought their taste for beer with recipes developed over the years in Europe. A number of breweries





developed over the years in Europe. A number of breweries sprang up in the area with many, in one form or another, surviving to serve guests these days.

But beer was not the only beverage in favor with the arriving immigrants. It has been said that the "16th century church reformer Martin Luther also had some thoughts on wine, being quoted as having said that "beer is man-made, but wine comes from God." There must be some credence to this claim since, in a typical year, the German people consume over a half-million gallons of wine. For this reason, you will have choices to select various wines or beers during this tour, based on your tastes . . . as part of the tour package.

In keeping with the theme of this tour, we will be dining in the heart of German Village at a restaurant that's been there since 1886. Here, we will be dining on German specialties and, this year, our staff has again added entertainment to enjoy during lunch!
