This tour, with two great destinations, begins in Gettysburg, the location of the major battle of the Civil War and a turning point in that conflict. Putting the activities of those days into perspective, we have reservations for the NPS's *"New Birth of Freedom"*, narrated by Morgan Freeman, to set the stage for the rest of the tour, and then viewing the Gettysburg Cyclorama with the dramatic 1884 painting *"Pickett's Charge"*.

We will be traveling through the Battlefield aboard our motorcoach with our guide, visiting the site where the Confederate Army of Northern Virginia, with 70,000 men under the command of General Robert E. Lee, and 94,000 men under the command of Major General George G. Meade, fought for three days during July of 1863. Our tour of the Battlefield is not just a ride-through, but



rather an unbelievable "experience" with a Licensed Guide, giving a tour as graphic as if he/she had lived through each moment of that time.

The next day finds us in Lancaster where we have reserved seats to attend the new musical, *"Noah"*, performed at the Sight & Sound Theatre. "With a catastrophic storm on its way, Noah is given a monumental task: build a boat big enough to save his family from a flood that will cover the entire earth. As Noah endeavors to live faithfully in the midst of an increasingly chaotic world, can he trust that God's promises run deeper than the rising waters around him?".
