## CLEVELAND'S SUBMARINE TOUR & LAKE CRUISE THUR AUG 14, 2025

Last year the Port of Cleveland welcomed over 46 Cruise Ships, emerging as one of the more frequented destinations on the Great Lakes. But ships arriving in

Cleveland really are not anything new. As a matter of fact, way back in 1900, the first ship built exclusively for luxury cruising was the German vessel, Prinzessin Victoria Luise. Over the years, many other ships joined in this trade, including the Aquarama that many of us may recall from the 1950s. Save \$4 with our Roll Back Pricing for 2025.

In more recent times, Cleveland has seen several dining-cruise boats and a series of Goodtime Cruise vessels. It is also home to the William G. Mather ore carrier, the 1,000-passenger Goodtime III and the U.S.S. Cod submarine, first launched in 1943. The submarine, now a museum, is docked in Cleveland's North Coast Harbor in the Downtown area. During our tour we will be, as they say, seeing what makes this mechanical marvel "tick".



Whether you, a relative or acquaintance were involved with any submarines, you will be learning about the USS Cod, its heritage and her role in WWII submarine combat. Afterwards we will be going just a couple hundred feet west to another dock, this time to enjoy an early-afternoon cruise atop Lake Erie and the Cuyahoga River aboard the beautiful Goodtime III, one of the largest ships on the Great Lakes. We plan on welcoming the warm rays of the sun as the captain narrates the sights and tells the history of both waterways that you will be seeing. As always, a hearty luncheon is included today!
