Cleveland is most fortunate to have one of the very few “Garden-Style Cemeteries”, and ours is known as Lakeview Cemetery. It has been described by many as an “*outdoor museum and arboretum*”, being the final resting place of President James A. Garfield, Eliot Ness, Dr. Crile and many of the early settlers of this region.

In addition to the President Garfield Memorial, it is home to what is proclaimed to be the “greatest architectural treasure” of this 285-acre cemetery, the Jeptha Wade Memorial Chapel. While the outside is not overly fancy, the inside is beautiful, having been designed by Louis Comfort Tiffany.

This Cleveland tour includes cruising along the city’s shoreline. At the Port of Cleveland, we will be boarding the 1000-passenger Goodtime III (see photo, lower front cover of this Tour Book) and having lunch today before enjoying a Lake Erie & Cuyahoga River Cruise.
