There is a lot of history in Canton and, about 36 years ago, the wife of an eighteen-term congressman from Ohio, had an idea after sitting through get-togethers with the wives of many American Presidents. Her husband was already recognized for his work on behalf of his hometown by waging a battle to prevent the name of Mount McKinley, the tallest mountain peak in the country, from being changed. After all, it was named after one of the most remarkable people to ever live in the area.

His wife was most influential in bringing the First Ladies National Historic Site to the city. She also worked to raise the funds for a historian to chronicle bibliographies of the First Ladies . . . and the rest is history, as you will see during our visits to both sites.



History continues, as the site includes the Ida Saxton McKinley Historic Home, built in 1895. It is quite a story as to the amount of influence that the First Ladies had on their "President Husbands". We will also be visiting the Education & Research Center, now part of the First Ladies Library. We are planning on having our luncheon today, at "The Twisted Olive"; the luncheon is included, but "the olive is on you", if you are so inclined. A stop will be made at Fannie May Chocolates before we travel homeward.
