Gettysburg saw the major battle of the Civil War that was the turning point in that conflict. Putting the activities of those days into perspective, we have reservations for the National Park Service’s “*New Birth of Freedom*”, narrated by Morgan Freeman, followed by a viewing of the Gettysburg Cyclorama with the dramatic 1884 painting “*Pickett’s Charge*”.

We will be traveling through the Battlefield aboard our motorcoach with our Licensed Battlefield guide. We will be touring the site where the Confederate Army of Northern Virginia, with 70,000 men under the command of General Robert E. Lee, and 94,000 men under the command of Major General George G. Meade, fought for three days during July of 1863. While a third of General Lee’s troops died during the fighting, only one civilian, Jennie Wade, died during the battle. Our tour of the Battlefield is not just a ride-through, but rather an unbelievable “experience” with a Licensed Guide, giving a tour as graphic as if he/she had lived through each moment of that time.

Gettysburg has also been called “*one of the most haunted towns in the Country*” as a result of the battle fought here and we will be having you see it from a unique perspective as we take an informative “*Haunted Gettysburg Walking Tour*” with our local “*Ghost Guide*” after dinner, a Great Day! extra during our visit to this most-historic town in America’s history.
