AMERCA'S 250 - AT THE DENNISON DEPOT

Departure locations, if applic: Parma/Cleve.West, Middleburg Hts, Independence, Beachwood/Orange, Macedonia.

A designated National Historic landmark, the Dennison Railroad Depot Museum has kept alive an important part of America's history. It is the most significant remaining example of a Railroad Canteen. During World War II, over 4,000 volunteers fed 1.3 Million Service Members as their trains arrived in town. Because of its contribution, the soldiers nicknamed the Depot "Dreamsville USA".

Today, our destination is the beautifully restored 1873 Pennsylvania Railroad Depot, a place that served as the Panhandle Division Headquarters.



You will have both time and admissions to explore the Museum's Railroad History, seeing exhibits and visiting an interactive Railroad Car Exhibit, not to mention having some time to visit the Whistle Stop Gift Shop. Our Staff is also working to coordinate our arrival so that you will be there when the train arrives with its carloads of passengers. Besides trains and rail memorabilia, the coordinators have advised us that there will be food trucks for you to select from, an air show, car show performers & actors to fill the time that you will be having here.
