TEA ROOM TO CANAL BOAT CRUISE

TUES JUNE 2, 2026

Departures, as applic: Elyria, No.Olmsted, Middleburg Hts., Independence, Beachwood/Orange, Macedonia.

This tour takes you to a quaint canal-era town, Canal Fulton, as we return to a simpler time in the development of both our nation and our state. It was the first settlement in this part of Stark County when it began in 1826. It eventually became a village, and its name was a combination of the names of the Ohio Canal and Ben Fulton, an early settler here. We will be taking a ride on the St. Helena III canal boat, reminiscent of the vessels that plied the waters of the Ohio and Erie Canals.



Our luncheon carries on the theme of the tour as we will be dining along the Tuscarawas River in a building dating back to 1814 . . . the Dragonfly Tea Room. We will be making other stops of interest today including a popular nursery and wrap-up the afternoon when our Tour Director spends "some of the boss's money" at the Almost Heaven Ice Cream Shoppe.
