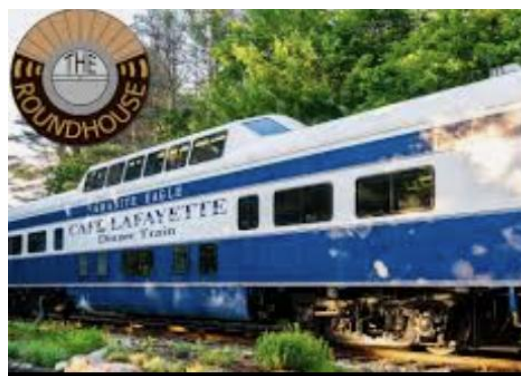

The month of June brings out the blossoming of the captivating Fields of Lupine, brilliant spikes of the wildflowers that carpet local fields and pastures in a rolling sea of purples, pinks, blues and whites. The long-lasting blossoms attract equally dazzling butterflies and create a floral display against the majestic backdrop of the mountains. Our first day along the way takes us to a number of interesting sites before we check into the Burrstone Inn where dinner awaits us.

The next day, following breakfast, we will be enjoying a scenic ride on the Cannon Mountain tramway. Enjoy the scenic views of the Franconia and Kinsman Mountain ranges before checking in to our hotel for our evening wildlife presentation!

Following breakfast the next morning, we venture to the summit of Mount Washington, the highest peak in the Northeast, aboard the world's first mountain-climbing cog railway, now operating on both steam and diesel power.

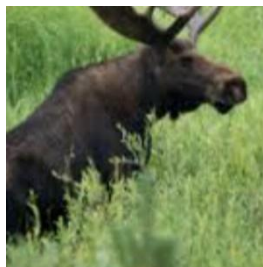
