During the three days of this tour, with its new itinerary that centers around "The Windy City", we will treat our passengers to a total of five meals, one of them being a live evening dinner show, plus an architectural cruise through the city, admission to two museums as well as an aquarium that is sure to delight, and, of course, two nights of rooms.

Our Tour Planners have included a "bit of history" at our very first stop as we view stately Motor Cars that were seen on the streets of Chicago over the years along with other automobiles, military vehicles, and Presidential carriages that were part of the late 1800s transportation scene; this museum even boasts a carriage that carried President Abraham Lincoln!

The first dinner of our trip features an establishment that takes you all the way back to 1929. Step into the world of gangsters and flappers as you give the password at the door and are served a fabulous three-course meal. Sit back, relax, and enjoy the show!



Shedd Aquarium, first opened in 1930, is the third largest aquarium in the Western Hemisphere (only after the Georgia Aquarium and The Seas at Epcot). You will have time to walk through the over 32,000 animals and sea creatures the aquarium holds! Travel through the Amazon Rising Exhibit and see how diverse the animal demographics truly are or head over to the Abbott Oceanarium and immerse yourself in the coastal ecosystem of the Pacific Northwest!

See all types of furry friends such as the California Sea Lion and Otters, or other ocean sharing creatures like the Moon Jellyfish!

Far from all you will be seeing, one of the most fascinating inclusions will have you experiencing a "legendary Chicago Architectural Cruise". You'll be seeing the 130-year long history as we travel through the heart of the city. We, of course, have included some free time for you to enjoy the famed Navy Pier following our tour!

All tour details are anticipated at the time that the Scheduled Tour Brochure was prepared and specific stops and/or other inclusions are subject to change or elimination without notice. The museum of Science & Industry is housed in the former “Palace of Fine Arts” from the 1893 World’s Columbian Exposition. This museum was initially endowed by a President of Sears, Roebuck & Co. when it opened in 1933. Exhibits include a German submarine (U-505) captured during WWII, a huge 3,500 square-foot model railroad, and the command module from Apollo 8. You will also be able to see “Silver Streak, the Pioneer Zephyr”, the first diesel-powered streamlined stainless-steel passenger train. Most interesting is the new entranceway which has been constructed similar to the iconic Louvre Pyramid in Paris! Afterwards, we will be going to an upscale dinner at one of the top restaurants in the Chicago area. Bon Appetit!
